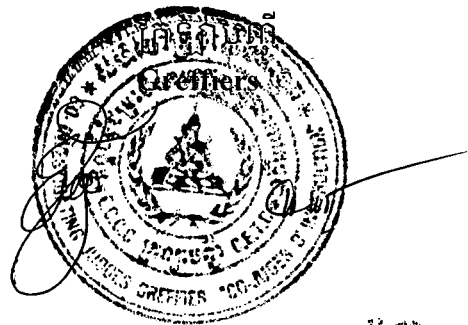



NOTICE OF APPEAL

1. Pursuant to Rules 74 (2) and 75 (1) the International Co-Prosecutor¹ files this Notice of Appeal against the Co-Investigating Judges' "*Decision on International Co-Prosecutor's re-filing of three investigative requests in Case 003*" dated 27 July 2011 and notified on 28 July 2011 ("Decision").²
2. The International Co-Prosecutor hereby notifies the Co-Investigating Judges and the Pre-Trial Chamber that, in accordance with Rule 75 sub-rules (3) and (4), he will file with the Pre-Trial Chamber within 30 days of the date of notification of the Decision his submissions on appeal. These submissions will contain the reasons of fact and law upon which the appeal is based together with all supporting documents.

¹ The *Notice of Appeal* is filed by the International Co-Prosecutor alone as the National Co-Prosecutor disagrees with this action. Although the International Co-Prosecutor considers recording this disagreement is not necessary for the filing to be valid, it nonetheless has been recorded in a register of disagreements kept by the Greffier of the Co-Prosecutors to ensure it is in compliance with the Co-Investigating Judges' "*Decision on time extension request and investigative requests by the International Co-Prosecutor regarding Case 003*", dated 7 June 2011 (D20/3). The 7 June 2011 decision is also the subject of an appeal pending before the Pre-Trial Chamber.
