**Rule 10.10: Transit**

Paragraph (a), second sentence, *should read*

If an unscheduled landing occurs on the territory of the transit State, that State shall, to the extent possible under the procedure of national law, detain the sentenced person in custody until a request for transit as provided in paragraph (b) of the rule or a request under article 89, paragraph 1, or article 92 is received.
